WHO CAN REGISTER?

- Aged 16 or over
- British citizen
- Commonwealth or EU citizen resident in Britain
- British citizen living or working abroad

DEADLINE

The deadline for registering to vote in time for an election is 11 working days before an election. Check if you are registered by entering your postcode via aboutmyvote.co.uk

HOW TO VOTE?
